- Every child is a competent learner from birth, who can be resilient, confident, capable and self-assured.
- We encourage children to recognise their own unique qualities and identify characteristics they share with other children.



- Children learn to be strong and independent from a base of loving and secure relationships with parents and/or a key person.
- We believe in building respectful and caring relationships with all children and families while focusing on learning and achievement. We support children to make friends and help them to think about what makes a good friend.



- The environment plays a key role in supporting and extending children's development and learning.
- At Sunshine Day Nursery we observe and assess children's development and celebrate achievements.
- We then plan the next steps in their learning to ensure continual progress. We aim to create a rich and stimulating environment conducive to exploration and learning.



- Children learn and develop in different ways and at different rates. They should not be pushed or pressured, as this inhibits their natural love for learning, but supported and encouraged to reach their full potential. All areas of learning are equally important and inter-connected. Underpinned by the principles, the EYFS sets out 7 areas of learning
